Rules

World MTB-O Championship will be organized according with the Competition rules for IOF mountain bike orienteering events. Riding off the track, trail or path is prohibited. It is allowed running or walking off the track with the bicycle 20 cm above terrain.

Classes

One class for women and one for men. No age restriction.

Participation

Each federation may enter a team of up to 16 competitors - up to 8 women and 8 men. Number of officials is not limited.

Maximum number of competitors from one federation:

Sprint final - maximum 3 competitors in each class from one federation participate

Middle final - maximum 6 competitors in each class from one federation + current world champion of the discipline if she/he is the member of the Federation team

Long qualification - maximum 6 competitors in each class from one federation + current world champion of the discipline if she/he is the member of the Federation team

Long final - the best competitors from qualification race heats qualify for the final according to par $6.8\,\mathrm{Rules}$

Relay - two teams in each class from one Federation, each consisting from 3 team members.

Sprint - moderately broken terrain with high density of wide track with good rideability.

Middle - moderately broken terrain with net of asphalt roads densed by net of many forest track sand paths demanding technical skills.

Long - area of qualification is partly hilly and partly moderately hilly.

Part of the final terrain is hilly the another one is flat. Both terrains have net of asphalt forest roads densed by narrow or wide tracks and paths. Some of the path could be wet or broken by forest technique.

Relay - hilly terrain with high density of wide and passable track. in small part of the area are small forest track path which could be wet.

The SportIdent system will be used for all event. Competitors start with their own SI card. Organizer provides SI-card on request.
